Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>BRFDFCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>		
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>I Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.</i>
